CONSUMER PROTECTION (SAFETY STANDARDS FOR PRIMARY BATTERIES)  
REGULATIONS 2013

IN exercise of the powers conferred by sections 19 and 150 of the Consumer Protection Act 1999 [Act 599], the Minister makes the following regulations:

**Citation and commencement**

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the **Consumer Protection (Safety Standards for Primary Batteries) Regulations 2013**.

(2) These Regulations come into operation on 1 September 2014.

**Safety standards for primary batteries**

2. (1) The safety standards for primary batteries shall be as prescribed in the First Schedule.

(2) The safety standards for primary batteries referred to in subregulation (1) shall apply to the primary batteries as specified in the Second Schedule.

(3) In this regulation, "primary batteries" means non-rechargeable batteries consisting of one or more basic functional unit known as cell which provides a source of electrical energy by direct conversion of chemical energy.
